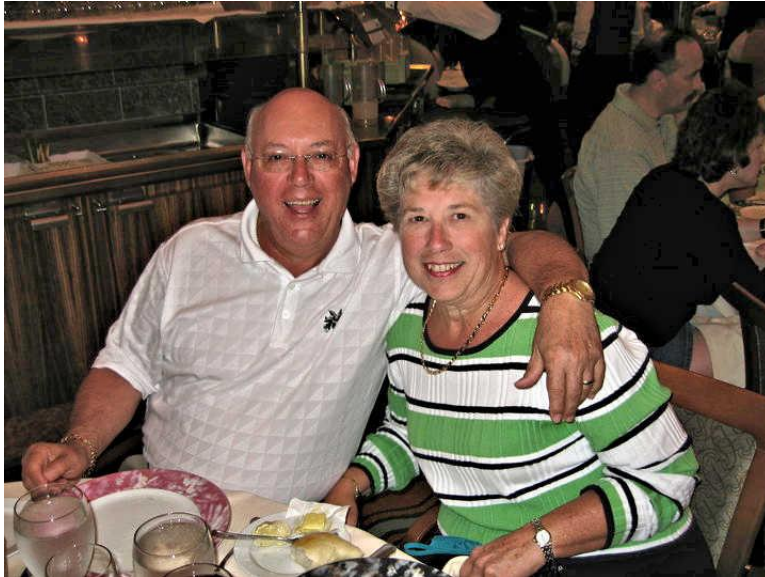


## David Lee Luzzi 25 July 1946 - 8 August 2021



David Luzzi, 75, passed away Sunday morning, 8 August 2021, after a long and courageous battle with cancer. He was born on 25 July 1946 in Pittsburgh, PA. Where he spent most of his life as a sales rep. He enlisted in the US Army and was stationed in Germany as an MP. He was an avid hunter and spent many weekends in the mountains hunting deer and telling stories with his friends. He is survived by his wife Carol, brother and sister-in-law Rick and Becky Luzzi of Naples, Florida, cousin Tony and wife Bonnie Staab of Carnegie, PA, and nephews Mark and Brian Luzzi of Pennsylvania.

As a proud US Army veteran, he will be inurned at the Beaufort National Cemetery on Wednesday September 1, 2021 at 11 AM.
